Paper decisions for the 2014 Midwest Macroeconomics Meeting at Florida International University (FIU) are posted on conference maker at the following link:

After signing in, please click on "My Submissions" to see the decision on your paper.

If you will see "Decision: Accepted," your paper has been accepted.

If you will see "Decision: Undecided," you are in the waiting list, meaning that we can still contact you for the possible inclusion of your paper in the meeting if any of the accepted papers will not make it to the conference.

If your paper has been "Accepted," you must register for the conference to confirm your participation by October 1, 2014. It is very important that you will register by this deadline of October 1, because, for any reason, if you will fail to register by this deadline, we will move to the waiting list to invite alternative papers. The registration will be open at the same conference maker link between September 24 and October 1:

We will send you a reminder e-mail to register when registration will be available on September 24. The registration fee is \$200. However, if you are a student, you will have a discounted rate of \$150. The registration fee includes a reception on Friday, Saturday lunch, and Saturday dinner, together with the transportation between the hotels and the campus before the first and after the last sessions.

Refunds will be available until October 8th with a cost of \$50. After October 8th, there will be no refunds.

The conference will be held on **November 7-9, 2014** on the main campus of FIU.
